BAHVN's Cindy Marty Hadge in Conversation With Family Members

Last month, BAHVN board member Cindy Marty Hadge was featured in an online talk with family members from NAMI-East Bay, a SF Bay Area NAMI affiliate. Cindy is a Lead Trainer for the Wildflower Alliance and Hearing Voices Network USA and she is an internationally award winning trainer and keynote speaker. Cindy spent many years struggling with trauma, use of both prescribed and un-prescribed drugs, and distressing voices, while receiving services from a mental health system that was at times helpful but was also frequently injurious.

She is now creating a life she finds worth living through the healing environment of the Wildflower Alliance, the Hearing Voices Movement, and a belief in a loving higher power. In doing so, she has found that all her struggles have value in creating space for herself and others to heal. Cindy will share her experience of navigating her voice hearing experience and supporting others to do the same.



Best Selling Author Ruth Ozeki Featured in Conversation with HVN-USA

Last month, bestselling author Ruth Ozeki was featured in a conversation with HVN-USA about her latest book, "The Book of Form and Emptiness". It tells the story of a young voice hearer named Benny Oh. The novel is narrated by one of Benny's voices. Although Benny experiences mainstream psychiatric care including psychiatric hospitalization, it is not the medical model that helps Benny make sense of his life.

Like many voice hearers, Benny makes meaning out of his experiences through developing relationships with fellow psychiatric survivors and voice hearers, and through finding ways to relate positively to his own voices. "The Book of Form and Emptiness" is a remarkable example of how the core principles and understandings of the Hearing Voices Network approach is influencing mainstream culture.
